Estimated Cost of Living	The Universidad de Valladolid estimate the cost of living is around €350-€400 per month. Campus Life (uva.es)

Insurance	For their temporary stay in Spain, students from the EU must get the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC) before leaving their countries.
Visas	Citizens of states not belonging to the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland must apply for a student visa.
Disability	<p>Some destinations may be more accessible than others for students with disabilities.
