

Terms and conditions

Edinburgh in Focus – Photography competition 2024-25

- 1. Entrants in the first three categories of the competition (*'Urban views'*, *'Campus and community'*, *'Nature and wildlife'*) must be current international (non-UK domiciled) students at the University of Edinburgh in the current academic year, or online learners studying outside the UK in the current academic year.
- 2. Entrants in the 'Global experiences' category must be current students at the University of Edinburgh who have been on a 'Study and Work Away' experience or exchange in this or the last academic year, or who are currently studying online outside of the UK.
- 3. Entrants in the 'Local meets Global' category must be current students at the University of Edinburgh in the current academic year.
- 4. Each entrant must submit only ONE photograph with a caption of no more than 150 words.
- 5. Entrants must provide their full name, student number, School, nationality (country of domicile), and email address so that their competition entry can be processed and credited.
- 6. The competition runs from 12 noon on 30 October 2024 until 12 noon on 10 February 2025. Late entries cannot be accepted.
- 7. Photographs must be at least 1800 x 1200 pixels. Submissions that do not meet this requirement may not be accepted.
- 8. Photographs entered in the competition must be the entrant's own work and should have been taken between 2023 and 2025 in Edinburgh or the local area, or where they are currently based while studying online/abroad for the 'Global experiences' category.
- 9. Before submitting a photograph of any identifiable person, entrants must have their consent and inform those persons that they are submitting a photo of them to this competition.
- 10. Entrants must accept that the photograph they submit to the competition may be used by The University of Edinburgh for any purpose without payment. In most instances, wherever possible, entrants will be credited if their photo is used.
- 11. Images may be shared with selected third parties. In most instances, wherever possible, entrants will be credited if their photo is used.
- 12. Entrants' personal data is secure. It will be shared for the purposes of publishing and crediting photographs; your name, school, country of domicile and photo caption may be shared with internal partners who may wish to share your photo, such as relevant Schools.
- 13. Obscene or inappropriate photographs will not be accepted, and organisers reserve the right to reject any photograph for any reason.
